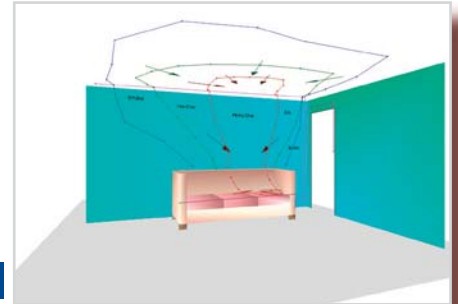

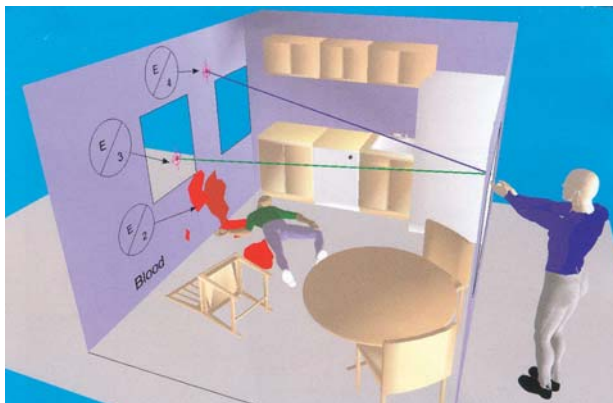

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

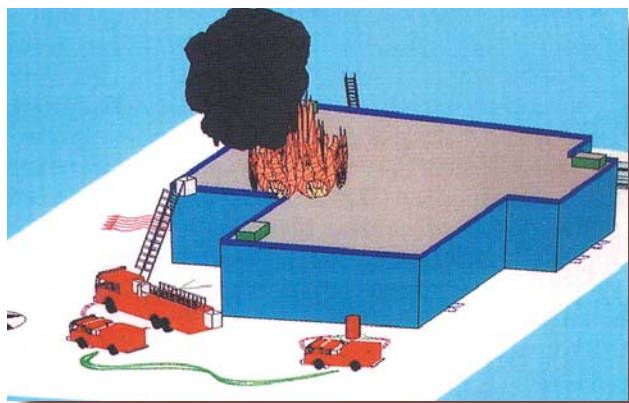
